LICENCE AGREEMENT FOR ECMWF PRODUCTS

Interpretation

Words in the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and words used below shall mean:

Products: Data from operational and research seasonal re-forecasts, interpolated to a standard grid as requested in the CHFP protocol. Real-time forecast data are **not** included.

ECMWF: The European Centre For Medium-Range Weather Forecasts (ECMWF) whose principal place of business is at Shinfield Park, Reading, RG2 9AX, United Kingdom.

Registered users: users working on CHFP who are authorised by the Licensee to access and use the Products subject to the same conditions as are set out in this agreement.

CHFP: The Climate System Historical Forecast Project, a research project sponsored by the World Climate Research Programme WCRP.

Licensee: Centro de Investigaciones del Mar y la Atmosfera (CIMA), located at Intendente Guiraldes 2160 - Ciudad Universitaria Pabellón II - 2do. piso, (C1428EGA) Buenos Aires - Argentina.

Licensor: The European Centre For Medium-Range Weather Forecasts (ECMWF) whose principal place of business is at Shinfield Park, Reading, RG2 9AX, United Kingdom.

Conditions

- The Licensee is authorised to use on a nonexclusive basis the Products only in the context of CHFP for the following activities:
 - i. Research related to the aims of CHFP
 - ii. Other non-commercial research
- Except as provided in Condition 3 hereinafter, the Licensee shall not reproduce, distribute, license, transfer, assign, sell, disclose or otherwise forward the Products, whether in their original form or as part of a service where the original numerical values of the Products can be accurately rebuilt from the service, to any third party, without the prior written consent of the Licensor.
- The Licensee is authorised to distribute the Products to Registered users, subject to ensuring that Registered users are aware of the restrictions applicable to their usage which shall be the same as the restrictions set out in Condition 1. Registered users shall not be authorised to distribute the Products. The Licensee shall notify the Licensor if it becomes aware of any unauthorised use of the Products including by Registered users. If the Licensee becomes aware of any Registered user breaching its terms of use the Licensee shall terminate immediately such Registered user's access to the Products. Supply by the Licensee of the Products in breach of this agreement including supply to Registered users making unauthorised use of the Products shall be considered as a default of the Licensee and shall render the Licensee liable vis-à-vis the Licensor and shall lead, in particular, to the application of Condition 10 hereinafter.
- 4. The Licensee shall use the Products for the purposes indicated in Condition 1 only .The Licensee shall also ensure that Registered users shall use the Products for the same purposes as indicated in Condition 1 only. Any other use or distribution is prohibited. The Licensee shall also ensure that registered users shall acknowledge the origin of the Products in any scientific publication arising out of their use of the Products,

- All Intellectual Property Rights of the Products owned by ECMWF or its licensors shall remain the property of ECMWF or its licensors and the Licensee acknowledges the full title and ownership by ECMWF or its licensors of all the Products supplied.
- The Licensee agrees to acknowledge the origin of the Products in any scientific publication it produces arising out of the use of the Products. It will provide the Licensor a copy of such publication, upon request.
- 8. The Licensor makes no warranty as to the accuracy or completeness of the Products. All Products are provided on an "as is" basis. Any warranty implied by statute or otherwise is hereby excluded from this agreement to the fullest extent permissible by law. The Licensee shall also ensure that it shall make similar disclaimers to Registered users as provided in clause 8 and 9 of these conditions.
- Neither party shall be liable to the other under any cause of action for any loss of profit or loss of revenue (whether direct or indirect); any indirect loss; loss of goodwill, reputation or opportunity; or any loss of or corruption of data however so arising out of or in connection with this agreement whether or not that party had been informed of or was aware that there was a serious possibility of such loss.
- 10. The Licensor may terminate this Licence if the Licensee fails to remedy any breach of its obligations under this agreement within 30 days of notice from the Licensor, requesting the Licensee to remedy such breach.
- The validity, construction and performance of this agreement shall be governed by the law of England.
- In the event of a dispute arising in connection with this agreement, the Parties shall attempt to settle

- and shall ensure that Registered users provide the Licensee and/or the Licensor a copy of such publication, upon request.
- 5. The Licensee shall not use, store or deal with the Products in any way which contradicts the authorised use indicated in Condition 1 and/or the exclusions indicated in Condition 2 without the Licensor's prior written consent. The Licensee shall ensure that Registered users shall not use, store or deal with the Products in any way which contradicts the authorised use by Registered users of the Products.

their differences in an amicable manner; in the event that any dispute cannot be so settled, it shall be finally settled under the Rules of Conciliation and Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce by three arbitrators appointed in accordance with the said rules; unless otherwise agreed in writing, the arbitrators shall sit in England.
